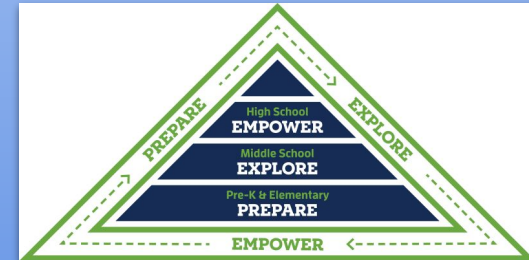
We have the privilege of seeing your student through until the end, with our all inclusive Pre-K - 12th grade school.

All About Pre-K

The Academy Charter Pre-Kindergarten has achieved the highest rating in the state quality and improvement monitoring system called, “Colorado Shines.”

A Colorado Shines rating is a symbol of quality. The Colorado Shines rating is a guarantee to families that our program is licensed, in good standing and meets basic health and safety standards.

Colorado Shines rates the quality of Colorado’s early learning programs, on a scale of 1 to 5, based on how well the program:

- Supports children’s health and safety
- Ensures staff are well-trained and effective
- Provides a supportive learning environment that teaches children new skills
- Helps parents become partners in their child’s learning
- Demonstrates good leadership and business practices

We have been rated a level 5 and have held that rating for 7 years.
